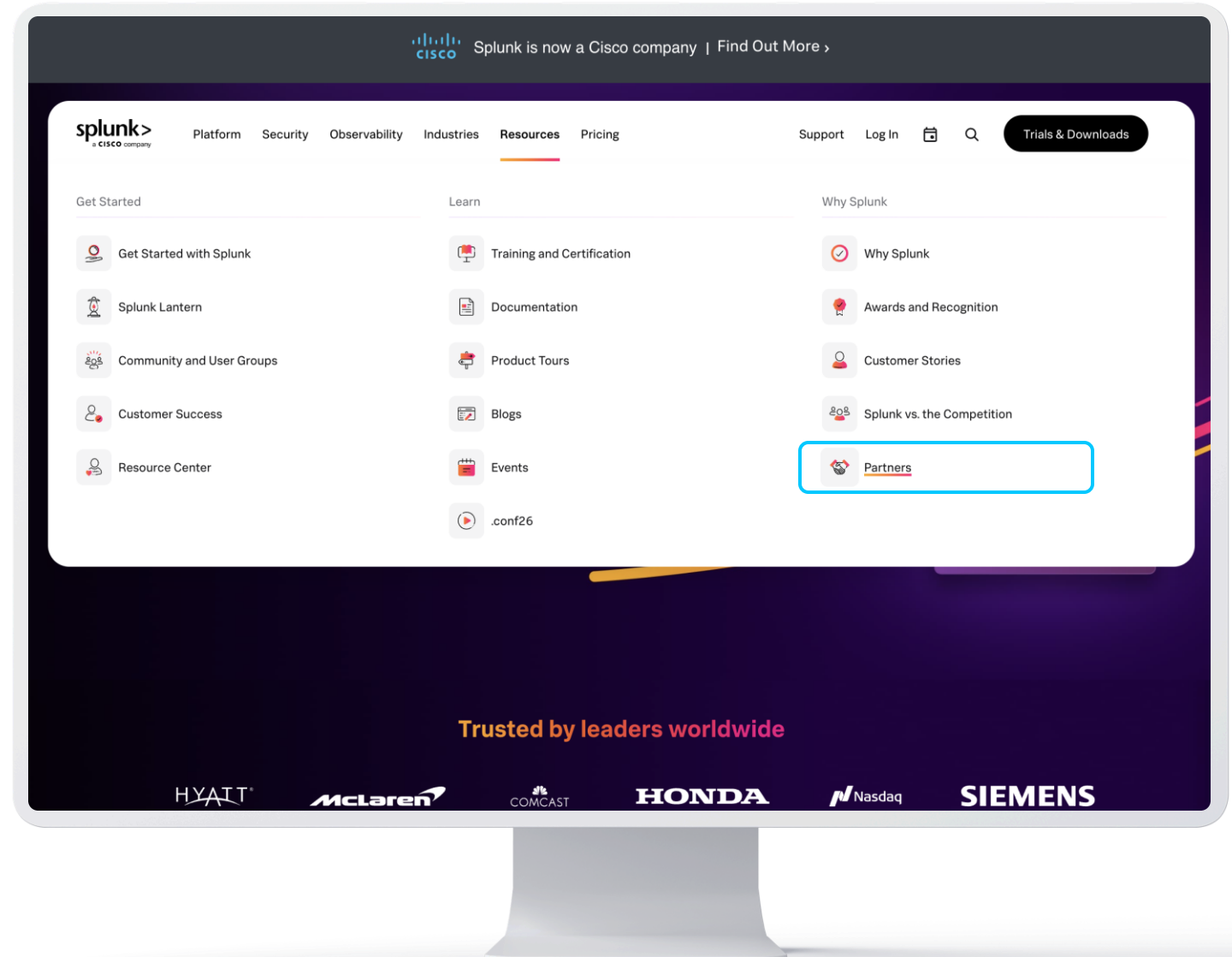

Step 1:

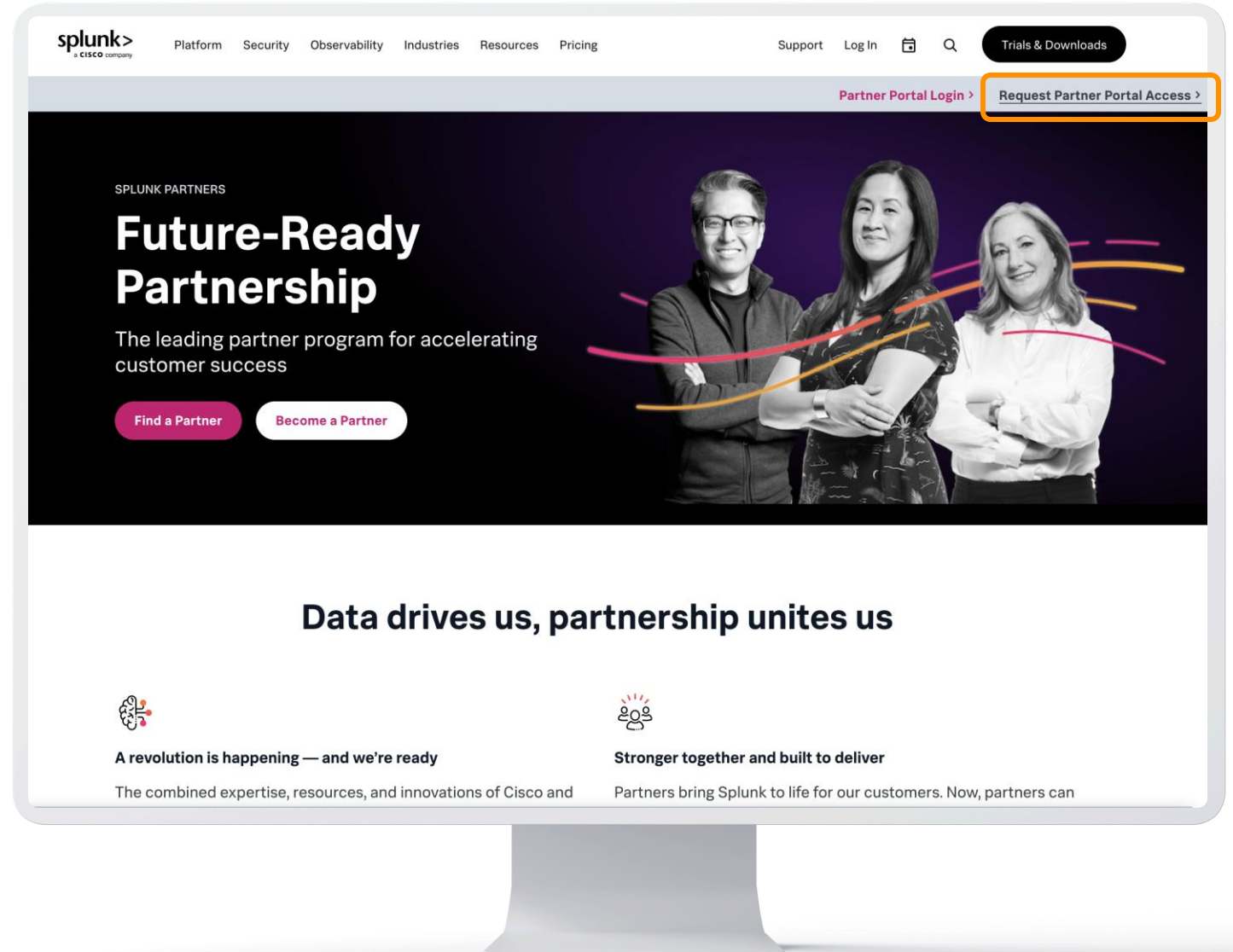
Navigate to www.splunk.com.

Select **Partners** from under the **Resources** tab in the top navigation.



Step 2:

On the Partner page, select **Request Partner Portal Access** in the top right hand corner of the page.



Step 3:

On the Partner Application page, input your **company email address**.

Make sure you use the **same email domain** that your company used when they first registered to become a partner. The system will recognize this domain and provision you as a **new user** within your company's existing partner account.


If your company is already registered as a Splunk partner, your account will be linked to your company's existing account automatically.

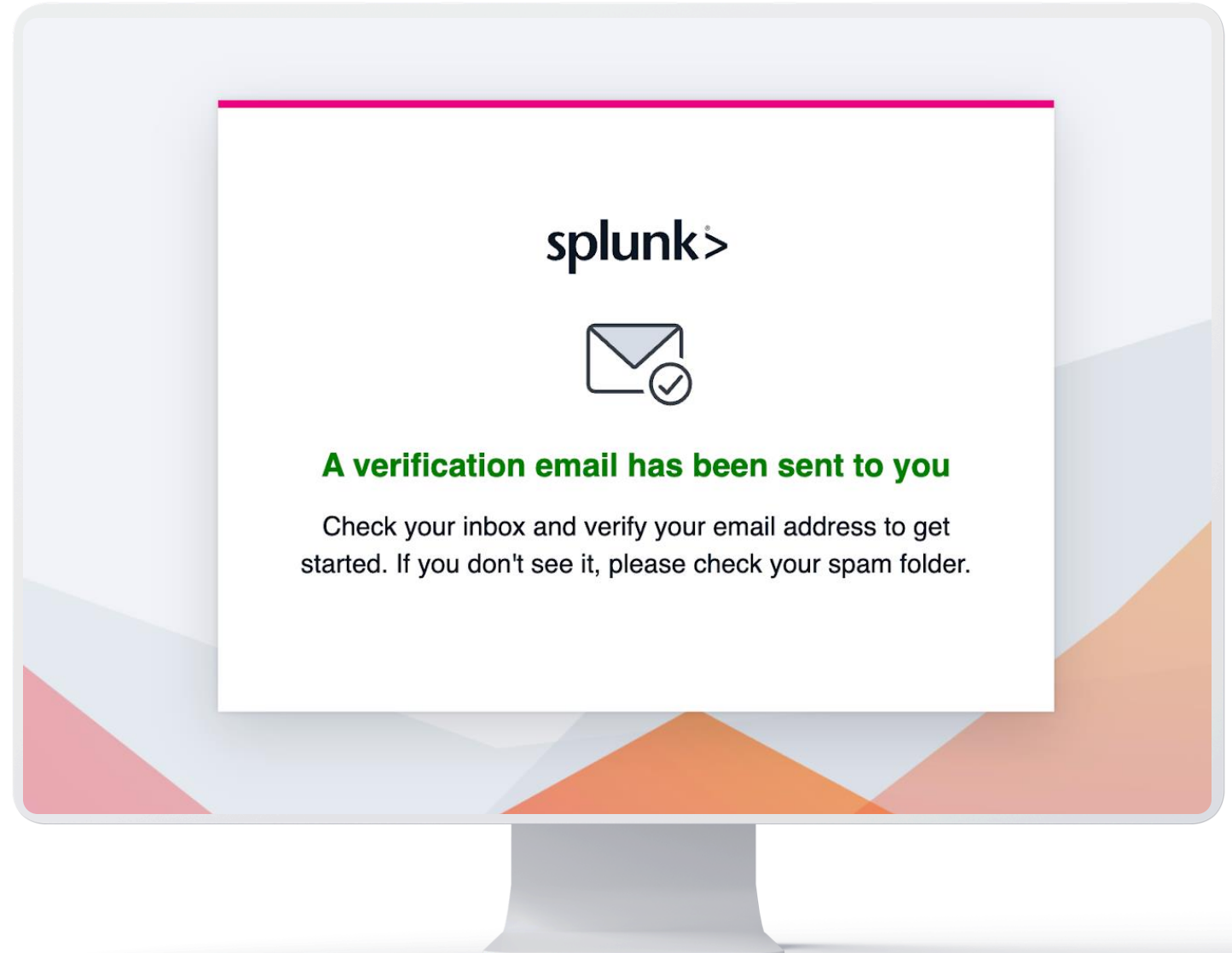



Step 7:

Once you have verified your email, you will be directed to the **Splunk Partner Registration** page. Fill out all available fields.

This is only for new partners. Disregard if your company already has an existing partner account.

If you are approved, you will be assigned as your company's **Primary Contact** since you first requested the creation of the account.

A Primary Contact has the privileges needed to action on accepting/acknowledging critical documents, applying to partner motions, badges, and more. If you are not the correct individual to be responsible for these actions, please email partnerverse@splunk.com to have the designated Primary Contact updated.
