

Online Proctored Exam Delivery

Splunk Certification candidates who wish to schedule an exam appointment via online proctor should visit [OnVue support](#) for up-to-date information on policies and procedures.

A brief summary of key policies is provided below:

- As of April 2021, candidates must log in **30 minutes prior** to their scheduled exam time to complete their system test **at the time of login**.
- Candidates using Mobile ID check-in on an Android device must have at least 3GB RAM available.
- OnVUE technical requirements are available [here](#)—please review in detail.
- Candidate's workstation must be **clean** and **clutter-free**. This also means candidate must be **alone** in a private home/office setting. Excess equipment (monitors, speakers, general office supplies) must be removed. Exams cannot be delivered to candidates in coffee shops, airports, or other crowded settings.
- Any interruptions to the workstation or room during exam delivery will terminate exam delivery.
- **All background apps must be disabled** prior to initializing the exam. Any background process will terminate exam delivery.
- Photo ID requirements for online proctored **differ** from those for testing centers. Please visit the [Online Proctored page](#) for more information.

Candidates who fail to meet any of the PearsonVUE requirements may be subject to automatic exam termination and/or forfeiture of their registration fee.
